Budget Proposed for 2007-08 Year

At the August General Membership meeting, a proposed budget for the 2007-08 year was presented. A total income of \$41,972.00 and expenses of \$41,972.00. This included the addition of a Ham Dinner and variety show to raise an additional \$1500. The other proposed change is to give the "Walking with Karen Program" an additional \$300.00, over last year. This addition is to cover the extra costs that will be incurred to

bring Karen back to the states for her last operation. In the past her airfare has been covered with frequent flyer miles donated to her, but is no long a valid resource. It was requested at the August meeting that in September, we look at the budget for the 2007/2008 year versus the actual expenditures for 2006/2007 year.
