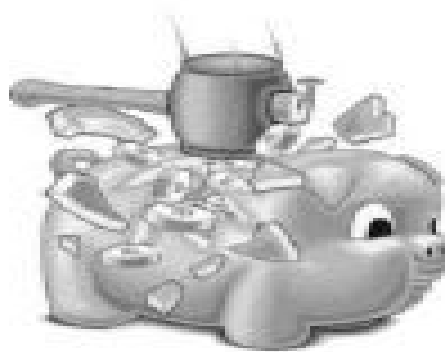

The revenue will come from several French Toast Breakfasts, Mardi Gras Party, New Years Eve Party, and the Persons with Disabilities (Tootsie Roll Sales) drive October 5th. The above will all go into a general fund and will be donated to the following Organizations/Charities: First Step School, Disaster Relief, Honduran Mission, March for Life, McAuley Center, National Camps for Blind Chil-



dren, Paul Beuie Boys & Girls Club, Sacred Heart, Special Olympics, St. John's School, St. Michaels Day Care, Village Outreach, and Walking With Karen. We also use the Pennies from Heaven fund when we have neighbors in need of a little help, do to an unfortunate time in their life. One new fund raiser we are doing is a Ham dinner and Variety Show on

Friday Night October 5th, with all proceeds going towards the landscaping project around the new A&E building. been a member of the board of Habitat for Humanity for two and one-half years. He

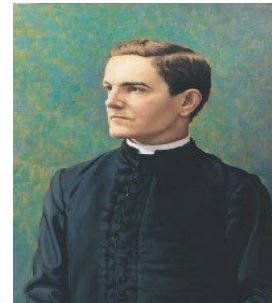
has been a member of the Finance Council of Sacred Heart of Jesus Church for three years and has been Chairman of this Council for the past two years.

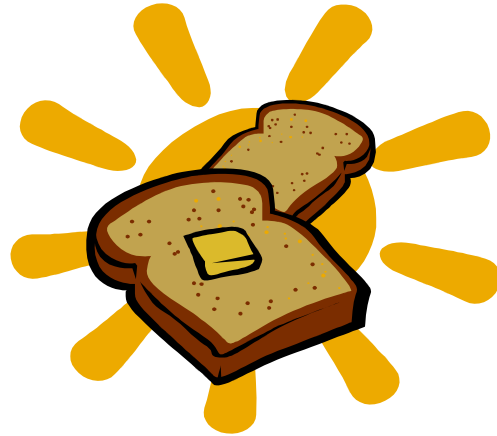
